- 1 Please ensure that you have paid enough tax in the relevant year to equal the amount that Oxfam Ireland will reclaim on your donations (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
Eg, if you make a donation of £50 Oxfam can reclaim £14 but only if you have paid £14 or more in tax within the tax year.
- 2 As your declaration covers donations you may make in the future, please let us know if you change your name or address while the declaration is still valid.
- 3 If, in the future, your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax equal to the tax that we may reclaim, it is important that you cancel your declaration by notifying Oxfam Ireland.
- 4 If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return.
